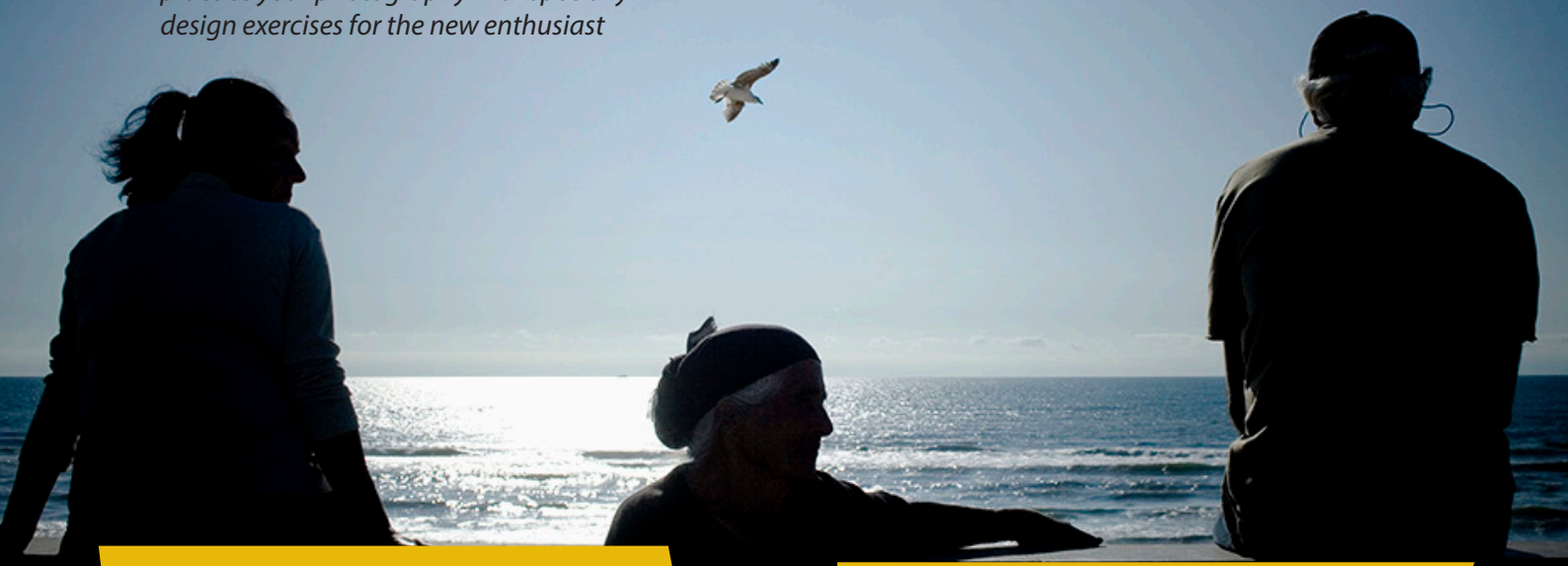

## BEGINNERS 2.0 PRACTICE

Autumn 2018

The beginners practice course aims to help new enthusiasts develop their recently learned skills. Students are taken through exercises that will automate their knowledge of the photographic process whilst also providing a set of solutions and workarounds for common situations and problems.

During the course, participants will be confronted with high-contrast lighting, backlit composition, candid portraits, fast moving objects, low light environments among other typical photographic challenges. With the help of the teacher, students learn how to evaluate their surroundings and subject, envision the image they wish to create and identify the corresponding photographic technique that will deliver the desired result.

The beginners practice course is the logical step forward for a truly independent photographer.
