DARKTABLE WORKSHOP - Post-production

Spring 2022

Darktable is an open-source, free software that functions as an Adobe Lightroom alternative. It helps photographers manage and post-produce their images. Although the initial learning curve for Darktable is slightly steeper then Lightroom's, the power and possibilities of Darktable outperform those of Lightroom.

The course aims to introduce photographers to the software and guide them in their first steps in achieveing a smoother workflow and maximizing their images' potential.

Drawing on the teacher's experience in photojournalism, editorial and portraiture, the workshop will tutor participants in Metadata, Keywording, Rating and Collections as well as post-production techniques like Colour Correction, Selective Adjustments, Black and White Conversion, Masking among others.

The course is open to everybody who wishes to better understand this platform but it is better suitted for photographers who already have a solid knowledge of the photographic process and wish to learn how to post-produce their images.
