Ideal for enthusiast photographers, this hands-on workshop aims to give students the technical photographic tools to better control their results along with tips and tricks to make them and their subjects comfortable in their roles. The course is centred around mixed theory and practice where every technique learned is workshopped in the second half of the class. After an introduction to standard lighting setups students learn how to identify patterns in natural light helping them to better compose their image.
