

PORTRAIT WORKSHOP

Autumn 2022

Ideal for enthusiast photographers and previous students of the Portrait Course, this hands-on workshop aims to give students the technical photographic tools to better control their results along with tips and tricks to make them and their subjects comfortable in their roles.

The course is focused on practice. Students learn how to identify patterns in natural light, try non-conventional techniques and tricks used by editorial photographers "on the go" while combining classic posing structures. The course's main goal is to help students improve their technique and their ability to improvise without the need for expensive studio equipment and to provide a tutored experience to a portrait session.
