

## STREET PHOTOGRAPHY WORKSHOP

Autumn 2022

Ideal (but not exclusive) for previous students of the Street Photography course who wish to practice their skills and receive further guidance.

The review session will happen online via a shared folder. Students will, with the help of the teacher, review each other's images, find patterns in each other's approach and suggest improvements for future outings.

The main goal of the course is to help participants find their "language" in the medium whilst helping them conquer the first challenge in street photography - pointing the camera at a stranger.

Students must possess a good grasp of their cameras and photographic technique.
